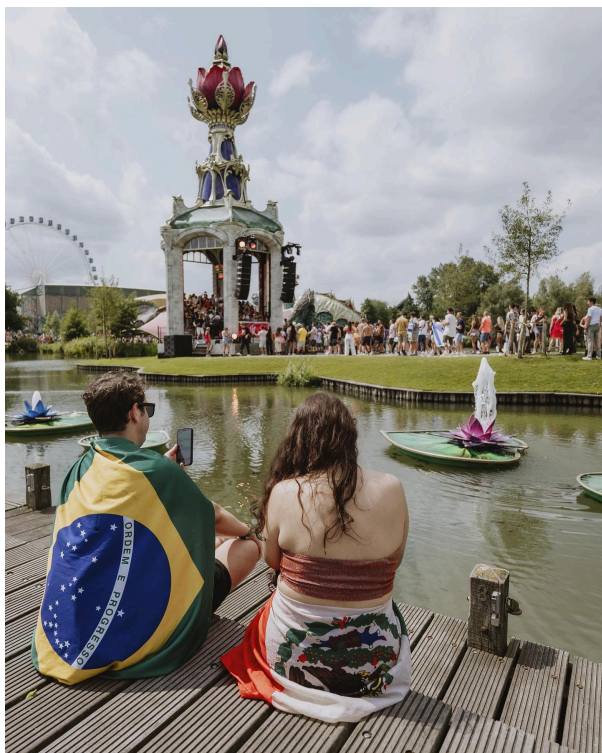


WELCOME TO MY JULY 2024 BRADESTINO® NEWSLETTER

Tomorrowland Belgium did take place across two weekends from July 19–21 and July 26–28, welcoming 400.000 People of Tomorrow from over 200 countries.

Brazilian DJ's are performing at Tomorrowland Belgium 2024



ALOK was part of the Tomorrowland Belgium lineup for the third time. He performed on the main stage on Saturday July 20th and had another performance at The Library, the event's second largest stage, on July 26th.

The artist behind hits such as “Hear Me Now” and “Fuego” has already played at the Tomorrowland event in the 2019 and 2022 editions. In an interview with CNN, the artist from Goiás revealed that he sees Tomorrowland as a family. He first got to know Tomorrowland by watching an after movie, but today he is the festival's ambassador in Brazil and has a documentary that portrays his journey with the event, “We Are Tomorrow”.

DJ ANNA, from Amparo, São Paulo, debuted in 2024 on the Mainstage of Tomorrowland Belgium and released music through Charlotte de Witte's label. The Brazilian DJ and producer reconstructed “Pulverturm”, a 1998 hit by German Niels van Gogh.

On the Belgian National Day (21/7) ANNA performed for the first time on the main stage of Tomorrowland. Furthermore, the Lisbon-based artist also played on the Crystal Garden stage, during the second weekend of the event, on July 27th.
